Possible suspect in theft of a purse from a campus office



On Oct. 24, a purse was reported stolen from an unsecured office in Gallahue Hall. A credit card from that purse was used at a BP gas station at West 71st Street and I-465.

A surveillance camera caught the suspect on film entering the business and later using the stolen credit card. Vehicle break-ins on campus and in the surrounding neighborhood
